This month we are adding yet another new Skidmarks feature, *Words From The Webmaster*. We will highlight additions or changes to the CLBG website, Issues and their resolutions, and the occasional helpful hint.

European General Data Protection Regulations (Say, what?)

If you use any online services, you've undoubtedly received an email or notice from each one about changes to their privacy rules as a result of new regulations. This also applies to Corvettes Limited Of Bowling Green KY Inc. We have been working closely with ClubExpress, our association management software vendor, to comply with these new regulations.

At the end of this month, when you login to our website, you will be redirected to a new screen where you will be required to answer a couple of questions:

1. You will be required to click an "I Agree" box for the updated Privacy Policy
2. You will also be asked whether you will accept general purpose communications concerning club or association business, such as newsletters and event notices. This question is required, but you have the option to accept or decline such communications.

Event Setup Form

The Event Calendar tab has been changed to read "Event Calendar & Setup." In addition to the calendar, you will find on that tab the new "Event setup form". Use this form as a guide for information needed to generate a club event. You can fill it on online (this is the quickest way), or print a paper form to fill out. If you complete the paper form you can give, Email, Snail mail or call the information to our Activities Director, Joe Tucker.

Sign On To The Website

When you go to our website, be sure to Sign On! When your are signed on, much more information is available to you, such as detailed information on calendar events, the Member Directory, the club Membership Meeting Minutes, the Financials, and much more which non-members (and those not signed on) are not allowed to view.

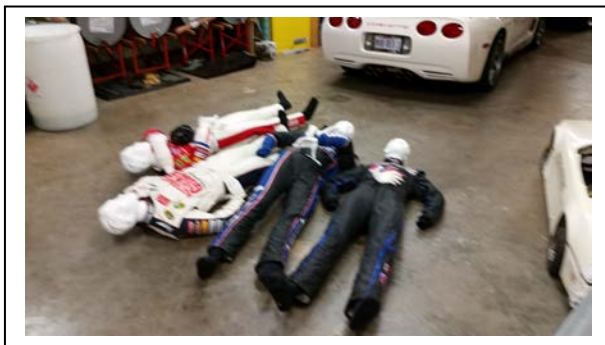

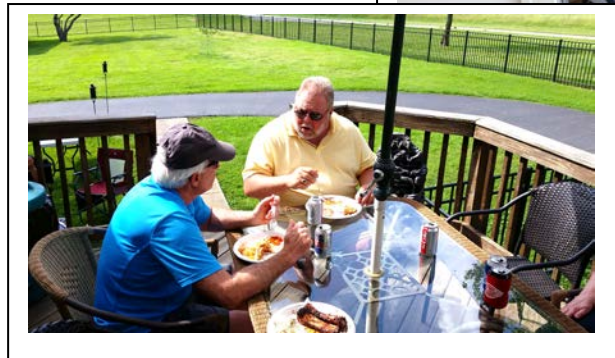

RECIPE OF THE MONTH!

Cauliflower Salad



I fell a little bit in love at the Marsh's BBQ last week – when I tasted Diane Blair's cauliflower salad. This recipe is tried and true, made every Thanksgiving at the Blair home, and for the occasional CLBG eat-a-thon. Enjoy!



Ingredients:

- 1 Medium head cauliflower, broken into florets
- 1 pound sliced bacon, cooked and crumbled
- 1 cup cubed cheddar cheese
- 1 medium green pepper, chopped
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 2 to 4 teaspoons sugar

Directions:

- In large bowl, combine cauliflower, green pepper and onion.
- Combine the mayo and sugar and spoon it over cauliflower mixture. Toss to coat.
- Cover and refrigerate for at least 4 hours before serving.
- Just prior to serving, mix in cheese and ½ of bacon. Garnish top of this salad with the remaining bacon.

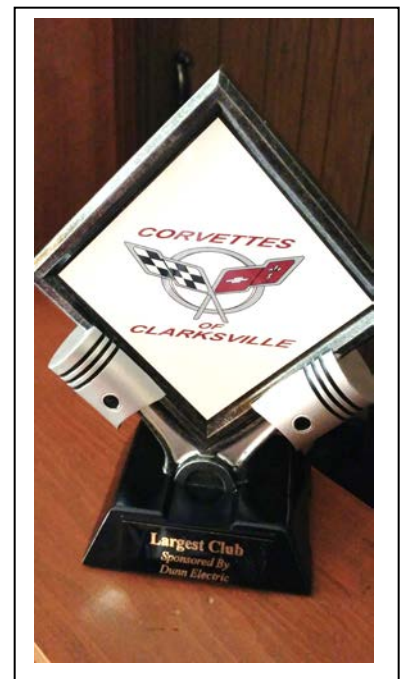
Diane's Notes:

- Broccoli can be used along with the cauliflower.
- You can line the bottom of the dish with crispy lettuce leaves prior to serving.
- Be sure to leave the bacon and cheese out until serving, as they will "wilt" if mixed in early!





