



RECIPE OF THE MONTH! Cake Bite Cookies



This cookie is named to describe the experience when eating one. It is very much like taking a bite of a piece of cake. This morsel is very tender, (like an unfrosted piece of cake), not overly sweet (like an unfrosted piece of cake) and very easy to make. I think you will find making it a piece of cake!



Ingredients:

- 1/2 cup butter
- 8 oz cream cheese (block, not tub)
- 2 large eggs
- 1 1/2 Tablespoons vanilla
- 3 cups flour
- 1 1/2 cup granulated sugar
- 2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- Powdered sugar (use to roll cookies in prior to baking)

Directions:

- Preheat oven to 350 F.
- Cream butter and cream cheese, then add eggs and vanilla and mix until well blended.
- In separate bowl, combine flour, sugar, baking powder and salt.
- Gradually add the dry to the wet and mix until smooth and combined.
- Cover the bowl and refrigerate the dough for at least ½ hour.
- Use 1.5 to 2 Tablespoons cookie dough to form a ball and roll the cookie in powdered sugar to completely coat.
- Place cookies on parchment paper on the cookie sheet and bake for 10-12 minutes.
- Allow the cookies to cool completely on the sheet before removing them from the pan.

Susan's Notes:

• The dough is sticky when you are forming the balls. I found it easiest to just drop the spoonful of dough into a shallow dish of powdered sugar, and then roll it around in the dish.
