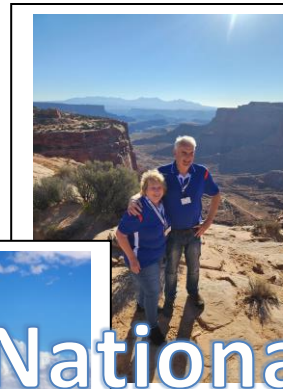
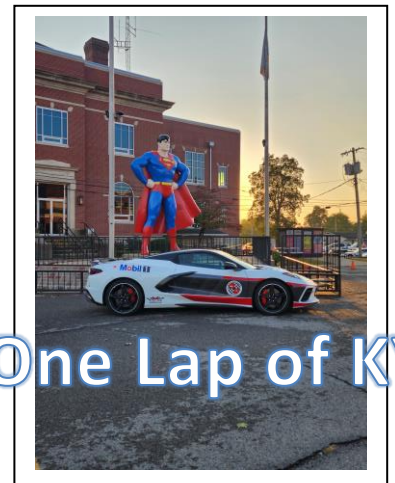
WHAT'S TO LOVE ABOUT MUSEUM IN MOTION

After taking part in four different NCM Museum In Motion (MIM) trips this year, I want to share just what they are and why you may want to schedule a MIM (or two) on your 2023 calendar. The purpose of the trips is to offer the Corvette community a way to visit a part of America, meet and enjoy the company of other Corvette enthusiasts, and, for most of the trips, drive your Corvette. NCM acts as your travel agent, setting up all details of the trip and providing a complete package for rooms, events, etc.

As you learned from my earlier missives, Terry and I took part in four trips this summer and fall. They were Explore Buffalo, the Branson Experience, the National Parks Tour and 1-Lap of Kentucky. Each of these trips took us to venues, events and sites which we likely would have never made it to on our own. But the best part of each of these trips are the people you meet and share the experience with. They come from across the country to participate. Normally, we are the only ones from Kentucky taking part – even (with the exception of Trooper Jonathan) on the 1-Lap of Kentucky! We have met some of the people on multiple trips, over several years, and have made many good friends. And we are not about to turn in our travel credentials quite yet. We just signed up to take the July 2023 Cruise to Alaska (okay, we will not be driving the Vette on that one!) and will again go on the 2023 1-Lap of Kentucky for our 7th year.

Events are added throughout the year. They are listed on the Events – MIM calendar on the NCM website. When you see a trip that interests you, Do Not Hesitate to sign up. Most of the trips fill quickly, many on the first day they are posted.

Did you know? ...There is a monument placed in the middle of the front circle at the NCM that a casual observer may think resembles a grave marker in a cemetery. There are no dead bodies buried below the marker (at least, I don't think so). But there is a sealed time capsule that was placed there during the NCM's grand opening on September 2, 1994. The scheduled opening of the capsule is set to mark and celebrate the centennial date of the 1953 Corvette. So, if you are still driving your '53 Corvette, be sure to be there in September of 2053 during the NCM Anniversary festivities.



A 2nd racing simulator is in the future? ...The NCM insurance office has outgrown the space where their office was previously located. The space is currently undergoing renovations that will eventually lead to the placement of a second race simulator. GM has provided the car chassis which will be modified for race fans to get behind the wheel and travel down the virtual track. Imagine a competitive race between the two simulators. It might happen. Work is expected to be completed by August 2023.

The growth in the NCM Insurance office leads to a need for more space. ...As mentioned in the above paragraph the NCM Insurance office has moved its office to 1440 Campbell Ln, Suite 600. An agent will still be available within the museum property.

The Limited Engagement Gallery is sure to please the need-for-speed person. ...The exhibit "Callaway Corvettes: 35 Years of Making Fast Faster" has opened and will be available for viewing until late in February 2023. 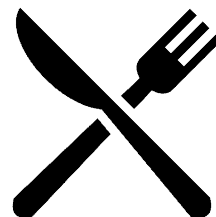


RECIPE OF THE MONTH!

Apple Crisp 🍏



I feel like all of you already know this recipe, probably because I grew up with it, and it is from the old Better Homes & Gardens cookbook. It is everything I want in a dessert – fast, easy, inexpensive. The crunch of the topping with the tender apple never lets me down. So, if you have never made this, or have long forgotten this dish from your past, you're welcome! I know you'll thank me.



Ingredients:

- 5 cups sliced pared tart apples
- 1 cup brown sugar
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup flour
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup quick-cooking rolled oats
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup butter (should be refrigerated but not frozen)

Directions:













- Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- Butter an 8-inch baking dish. (Or a 9-inch pie plate)
- Cover bottom of dish with the sliced apples.
- In separate bowl, combine brown sugar, flour, oats and cinnamon.
- Cut in butter until crumbly.
- Press topping mixture over the apples.
- Bake 45 to 50 minutes, until top is browned.
- Serve warm, top with ice cream.

Susan's Notes:

- Resist the temptation to melt the butter, or to let it get too soft. Cold butter will yield a crispier topping.
- You can use more apples for a deeper dish of delight.
- Warm, with ice cream is good, but I love it cold from the refrigerator (that is, if we have any left over to refrigerate!)
