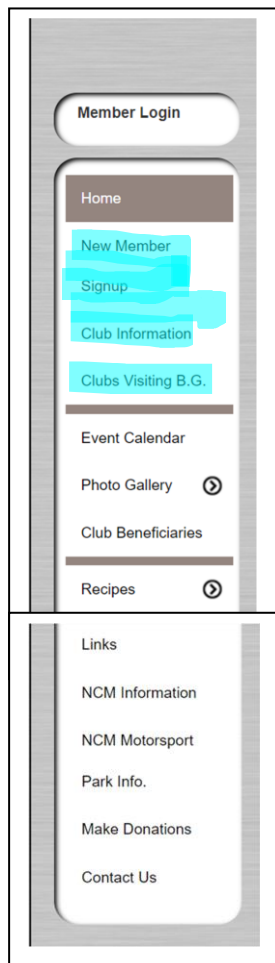

WOULD YOU LIKE TO SEE THE MENU?

This week we look at the CLBG website Menu. It lives on the left side of every window on the website, ready to give you access to most of the information throughout the site. The most important point I want to make is that signing on to the website will bring you much, much more information and access than not signing on. Let's look at the differences.

Not Logged In



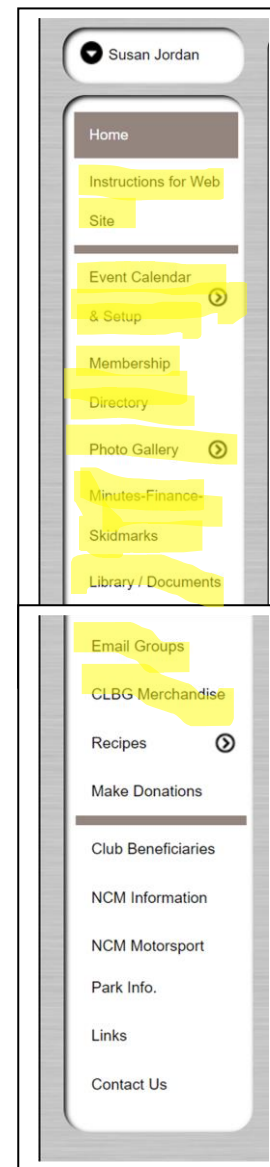
The differences between the two menus are highlighted.

A **not-logged-in** member (or non-member) will see the New Member Signup, which takes them to the screens where they can join the club.. They also have access to Club Information and Clubs Visiting B.G. Both contain information for non-members to learn about our club and Bowling Green.

As a **member**, when you **log on to** the website (Member Login is always at the top of the menu) there are several items that appear:

- Instructions for Website. This takes you to a list of links to detailed “how to’s” for many actions.
- Event Calendar & Setup – Yes, you can view the calendar if you are not signed on, but you cannot register for a club event until you login. This also gives access to Event Setup, which is where you can request a new event for the Club.
- Membership Directory. All the contact details for your fellow members.
- Minutes-Finance-Skidmarks – Links to the most current of these documents (which you learned last month are all three available directly on the Home Page of the website!)
- Library/Documents – Contains all past Minutes, Financials, Skidmarks, plus the Club by-laws, Bord members, member biographies, and more.
- Email Groups – where we can message the club members.
- CLBG Merchandise – Members only can order our shirts.

Logged In



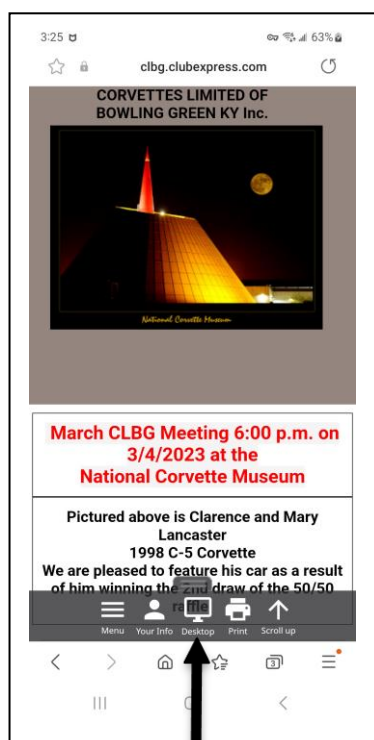
Note that all of the menu items not highlighted on either example are the same whether logged in or not.

CELL PHONE VS COMPUTER

The website can be accessed on both your cell and your computer. The information is the same on both, and all functions are available on both. I personally use my phone more often than the computer because, well, it's my magic pocket computer/communicator and I have it with me at all times. That is the big advantage of the phone, but the advantage of using the computer is of course the screen size and the ability to see much more without having to scroll from side to side or top to bottom as much as on the tiny phone screen.

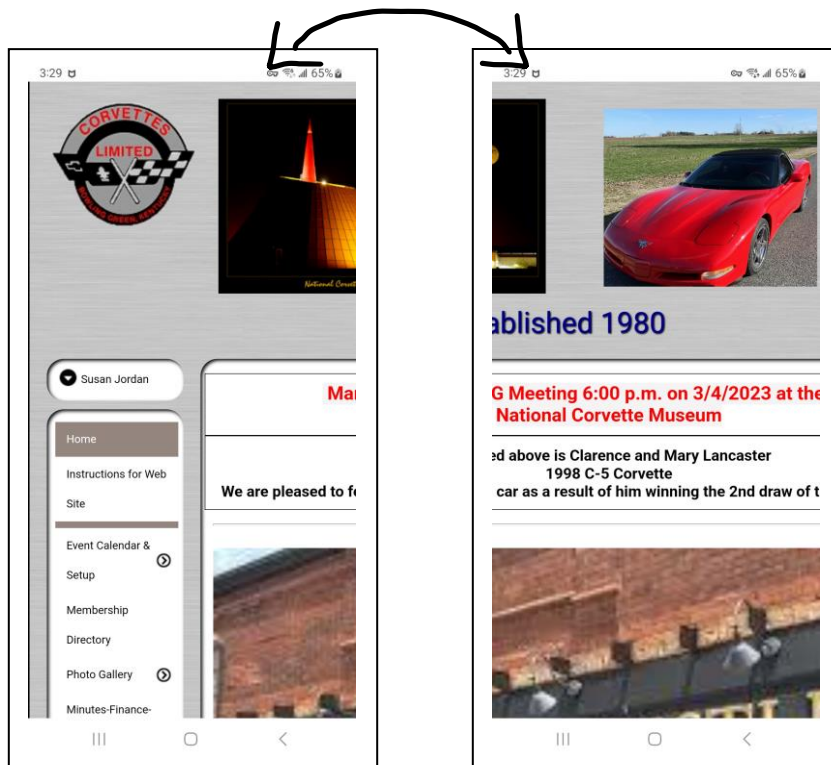
But I do suggest you try it out on your phone. I keep an icon to take be directly to clbg.us on my phone's home screen for easy access. But it is always available on your web browser of choice. Sorry – we do not have a CLBG App at this time.

When you go to the website on your phone, it is formatted specifically for smartphones. It doesn't look exactly like the windows on your computer, but it is made so that the screens (most of them) will fit the phone screen. If you want it to look like it does on your computer, simply look at the bottom of the screen and click on the Desktop icon. Now it will be formatted exactly like the computer version, but you will have to scroll back and forth to see all the data on each screen.



To change to Desktop view of the website, click on Desktop icon.

Once in Desktop view, you will need to scroll right-left to see entire screen.

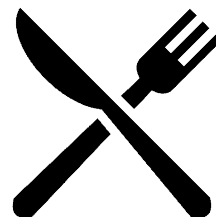
RECIPE OF THE MONTH!










- You can choose to lower the calorie count by using sugar free pudding and sugar free Cool Whip.
