






# Cruise to Trooper Island

# Recipe of the Month

## Creamsicle Orange Cookies

By now you know the keywords for my favorite recipes – Delicious, Fast, and Easy! This cookie recipe totally meets all three. I'd add one more to describe this one – Fun! Part of the fun was in how quick it was to mix up, and it is totally fun to see the bright orange color.

This recipe is from Trish, blogger on the Moms On Time Out website (momsontimeout.com)

### Ingredients:

- 15.25 ounce box White cake mix
- 3 ounces box Orange Jello gelatin
- 2 tablespoons Orange zest
- 8 tablespoons butter, softened
- 2 large eggs room temperature
- 11 ounces White chocolate chips



### Directions:

- Preheat the oven to 350°F. Line two large baking sheets with parchment paper (highly recommend!).
- In a large mixing bowl or the bowl of a stand mixer, whisk together the white cake mix, orange gelatin powder and orange zest until fully combined.
- Add the butter and eggs to the bowl. Use a hand mixer or stand mixer to beat the ingredients together just until combined, about 2 minutes, scraping down the sides and bottom of the bowl as needed.
- Add the white chocolate chips and fold into the cookie dough.
- Use a 1 ½ tablespoon cookie scoop to scoop out the dough, and place on the prepared cookie sheet. Repeat with the remaining dough making sure to leave about 2 inches between each ball.
- Bake the cookies for 10 to 13 minutes or until the edges are set. Remove the cookies from the oven **and let cool for about 10 minutes** on the baking sheet before removing to a cooling rack to finish cooling.






